Multi-Media Policy

(New as of February 2025)

In consideration of the opportunity to participate in the Congregational Summer Assembly ("CSA") activities, including but not limited to CSA lessons, meetings, , events and use of CSA facilities and equipment (the "Program"), the participant and the participant's family members and guests (the "Participants") agree to be subject to this Multi-Media Policy (the "Policy").
