Reid, Joseph E. Reeve and Robert C. Hawley, who had received the sum of \$100 to hold and manage, along with any additional gifts, in trust. The CSA has benefitted from their vision and actions many times over since that time.

In recent years the Pilgrim Fund has funded a new wireless microphone system in the Meeting House, renovation of the Meeting House restrooms (including replacement of the foundation under that portion of the building), and removal of several diseased trees. Two of the most visible impacts of Pilgrim Fund gifts at work in 2020 are the repaved entry to the Meeting house and renovations to the North Lounge in the Assembly Building.
