Becoming Mary Scully Presented by Philip D. Deloria

The Women's Association is honored to have Philip D. Deloria as our speaker at our Annual meeting this year. Phil is an historian who specializes in Native American, Western American, and environmental history. He currently teaches in the Department of History at Harvard University and is the author of the award-winning books, *Playing Indian* (1999) and *Indians in Unexpected Places* (2004), among others. His most recent book, *Becoming Mary Scully: Toward an American Abstract* (2019), will be the focus of Phil's presentation, as detailed below:

'Between 1927 and the mid-1940s, Dakota Sioux artist Mary Sully produced a unique and dazzling body of artwork, which mingled together American traditions of abstraction with the geometries of American Indian women's arts. Taking as her subject familiar figures from film, radio, music and media, she anticipated later pop and abstract artists, such as Andy Warhol. In this talk, Phil Deloria—her grand-nephew—interprets some of her most interesting work, while also placing her in historical context: Sully was the descendent of artists, generals, and medicine men; a person struggling with mental health issues; and a peripheral member of a Columbia University anthropology scene that included Franz Boas, Margaret Mead, Ruth Benedict, and Zora Neale Hurston.'

Phil's talk will be followed by a 2-minute break before we commence the Meeting.
